

# **COOKING CORNER ... CHRISTMAS CHUTNEY**

## (THINK AHEAD!)

#### INGREDIENTS

- 900g cooking apples, peeled, cored, and cut into 2cm dice
- 300g chopped dates
- 300g dried apricots, cut in half
- 400g raisins
- 150g dried cranberries
- 50g preserved ginger in syrup, cut into  $\frac{1}{2}$  cm dice
- 2 medium onions, peeled and finely diced
- 750g Muscovado sugar
- 2 teaspoons of mustard seeds
- 2 teaspoons ground ginger
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 700ml cider vinegar

#### METHOD

1) Place all ingredients into a large pan. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to a simmer and cook for 40-50 minutes until thick, stirring occasionally.

2) Remove from the heat and transfer into dry, clean, sterilised jars and seal. Store in a cool dry cupboard for at least a month and for up to a year.

#### TIP

If you like your chutney with a little extra crunch, add some walnuts. Lightly toast 150g, roughly chop (not too small) and add to the pan with the other ingredients.


