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Minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on

Wednesday 10 May 2023 at 6pm at Melling Village Hall

Present: Cllr Towers (Chair), Cllr Lewer, Cllr Nott, Cllr Jackson, Cllr Davies and the Clerk. One member of the public was present.

23/1 Apologies for absence:

None received

23/2 Minutes of the previous annual parish meeting held on 5 May 2022

The minutes of the meeting were approved and signed by the former Chair as an accurate record.

23/3 Annual report from the Chair of the Parish Council:

Councillor Towers reported that it had been a busy and successful year for the Parish Council and thanked all involved in making the work of the council run smoothly. The Parish Council was pleased to have co-opted Mary Jackson and Rob Davies as new councillors and wished them well in their new roles. She also expressed thanks to those councillors who had stood down during the year and wished them well for the future. She also thanked Cllr Nott for his dedication to the role of Chair during the last few years.

The Parish Council will continue to address issues raised by residents during the year such as flooding, safety barriers, speeding in the area and the mowing of the village green. During the course of the year the Parish Council has received grants for work on footpaths, has conducted a tree survey to ascertain the health of trees on the village green, has helped to fund successful jubilee events in the village hall and the Chair has represented the parish council at Blackburn Cathedral for the jubilee.

23/4 Statement of accounts for the financial year ended 31 March 2023:

The Clerk outlined the statement of annual figures. Income received included the precept of $\pounds 12,761$, VAT recovery $\pounds 2,130$, Melling Chronicle advertisers $\pounds 508$, and PROW grant $\pounds 500$. Expenditure included staff costs of $\pounds 3,114$, mileage/incidentals $\pounds 75$, Chronicle printing $\pounds 1,283$ and editing $\pounds 1,837$, insurance $\pounds 633$, village contractor $\pounds 3,450$, grass/hedge cutting $\pounds 900$, culvert clearing $\pounds 500$, tree survey $\pounds 400$, Jubilee costs $\pounds 250$, audit $\pounds 60$, Unity Trust charges $\pounds 36$, LALC subs $\pounds 53$, fencing $\pounds 1000$ (from grant) and Lancashire Environment Fund $\pounds 3,300$ (for Melling Village Hall). The end of year balance stands at $\pounds 2,483$.

23/5 Open Forum

The mowing of the village green was discussed. Although residents do not expect the village green to be mown to 'bowling green' standard dissatisfaction was expressed about the bottom

area of the green where nettles are growing very high and the weeds around the steps. Councillors agreed to look into the issues raised.

The meeting closed at 6.30pm.
